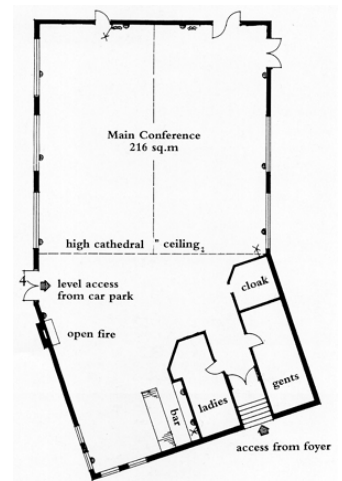

Conference Room Detail

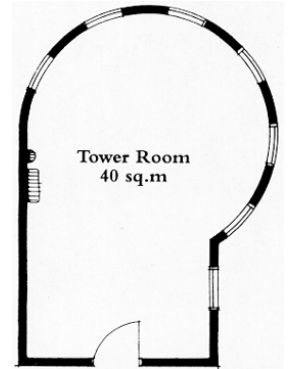
Main Conference Room

This large room is fully self contained with ladies and gents toilets, bar, cloak room, open fire, kitchen facilities etc. Located on the western end of the building with direct access from the car park and Tower Room, the main Conference Room features high cathedral style ceilings, spot and mood lighting, blackout curtains and a public address system.



Tower Room

This delightful room epitomizes old-world charm with its leadlight windows and high ornate ceiling. The unusual shape of the room allows considerable flexibility for placement of conference equipment. Located on the western side of the building the Tower Room provides direct access to the gardens.



Glenview Room

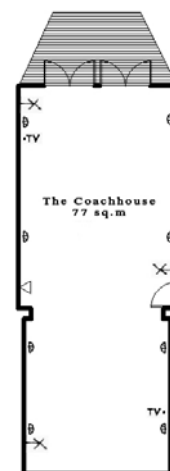
The Glenview Room has views to the south over the Jamison Valley and beyond. It is ideal for small meetings or as a breakout room.



The Coachhouse

The Coachhouse is a unique, stand-alone facility located adjacent to The Mountain Heritage.

The Coachhouse has a raked timber ceiling with historic timber trusses and a north facing wall of glass French Doors opening out onto its own balcony with direct access to the gardens and recreational facilities.



Breakout Rooms & Supplementary Conference Areas

All rooms can be used as breakout rooms including the rear of the main conference room.

Where a total bookout of the property is made, other areas of the building may be used for conference purposes if required. These include 2 lounge rooms, the restaurant and the library.

Accommodation

42 rooms are available including four Suites. All Suites and many of the rooms have magnificent views and are equipped with spa baths and romantic real flame fireplaces. All rooms have either a full sized bath or spa bath with shower over, toiletries, refrigerator, direct dial STD / ISD telephone, colour television, radio and individually controlled reverse cycle heating and cooling.

Meals

One of the highlights of Mountain Heritage is its fine cuisine served with breathtaking views in our Jamison Views Restaurant or in our main Conference / Function Room. Jamison Views enjoys a panorama of spectacular mountain scenery from its large picture windows during the day and on clear nights the twinkling lights of Sydney. Our conference / function rooms can be booked for private dining requirements.

- Morning Tea - A selection of boutique and herbal teas and coffee, juice and a bake of the day.
- Luncheon - Dependent on the duration of your stay and numbers, luncheon may include hot & cold buffet, Danish sandwiches, barbeques by the pool and cheese and fruit platters.
